FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS!

This is an annual 3-day tournament held between 2025, November 20-25 at Tobiume Arena in Dazaifu, Fukuoka, Japan.

This tournament will change destinations in Asia every year accordingly.

One director can express interest in 2 teams per country with a 12-man roster to participate. If you are in the USA or Canada, you can express up to 1 team per city.

Age 13-15: 9 players

\*We recommended having at least 3 players between the ages of 10-12 to gain experience alongside your older starters and role players. There will be a selection draft of all aged 10-12 for all participating teams to compete on Days 1, 2 and 3 (If necessary) for the YEBA U12 All-Star Series.

This tournament is 5v5 for Boys Only

Public High Schools + Private Clubs Are Allowed! Under 15s | Born 2010 - 2015

The Age 16 Summer Rule: Due to the event date being changed from August to November.

If you turn 16 between August - December 2025, you are eligible to play.

<u>The deadline for all full registrations is February 1, 2025.</u>

## Team placements | Round Robin x Single Game Elimination Hybrid System

All 8 teams will be required to play at least 5 exhibition games mixed with local and international ball clubs. The first 2 days will be seeding exhibition games to determine the final placements for the elimination rounds on Day 3.

\*During the seeding phase, teams who win exhibition games with the highest Points For vs. lowest Points Against averages will be seeded 1-4 accordingly for each group A and B.

### **Guaranteed Games**

Day 1: 2 games (Exhibition Group A vs Group B)

Day 2: 2 games (Exhibition Group A vs Group B)

Day 3: 1 game + (Elimination Day)

(1) Winning teams advance accordingly in their group to the championship and losing teams are eliminated from contention.

During the elimination rounds, group A and B teams will not compete until the championship game.

(2) Group A: Round 1 | 4 teams | Group B: 4 teams

(3) Group A: Round 2 | 2 teams | Group B: 2 teams

(4) Group A vs. Group B finalist: Round 3 | Championship game

#### **Awards**

1st place: Championship Trophy + Player MVP Trophies + Championship T-shirt

### YEBA All-Star Series for ages 10-12

A total of 24 players from the 8 participating teams will be drafted to two all-star teams to compete for first and second place.

Games will be played on Day 1, 2, and 3 (if necessary). We will also handpick 2 coaches through a raffle draft to coach these 2 teams before all teams arrive on November 20, 2025. We will host an online coach draft session for the All-Star series at a later date.

Three-Point Contest & One-on-One Contest for Ages 13-15 (The Age 16 Summer Rule is eligible)

A total of 8 players (1 per team-per event) will be selected by their coach to participate in each contest event.

## Tournament Rules, Officiating, Code and Conduct

FIBA rules are engaged and managed by Hai Navi Group.

Certified bilingual referees comprise 4 in total.

\*There are no defensive 3-second lane violations in our tournament, camping out is allowed.

Aged 13-15: 8 minutes per quarter/32 minutes total

\*The Championship game will be stopped clock on every Deadball

Aged 10-12: 6 minutes per quarter/ 24 minutes total
